RoHS

RoHS refers to Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (EEE), as amended, including Directive (EU) 2015/863.

The RoHS Directive restricts the use of the following substances in homogeneous materials above the stated maximum concentration values:

- Lead (0,1 %)
- Mercury (0,1 %)
- Cadmium (0,01 %)
- Hexavalent chromium (0,1 %)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0,1 %)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0,1 %)
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0.1 %)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0.1 %)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0.1 %)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0.1 %)

Based on information available from our suppliers, manufacturing processes, and material composition data, all stainless steel grades traded by Dacapo Stainless A/S comply with the requirements of Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS), as amended by Directive (EU) 2015/863.

This declaration applies to the stainless steel products supplied by Dacapo Stainless A/S and is provided to the best of our knowledge based on information obtained from our supply chain and internal product knowledge.
