RoHS 2011/65/EU

The RoHS directive 2011/65/EU (amended by directive (EU) 2015/863) restricts the use of certain hazardous substances in various electrical and electronical equipment. Most of Weidmüller's products are either directly or indirectly affected by the directive and comply with it, sometimes taking into account exemptions listed in Annex III. However, a few of our products do not fall within the scope of the directive and are therefore not affected by RoHS.

The RoHS compliance status, including information on the application of exemptions for our products, can be found in our online catalog at the respective article in tab "Environmental Product Compliance".

REACH 1907/2006

According to the regulation 1907/2006 "REACH" and in particular the obligations resulting from Article 33 we herewith declare based on our supplier statements that substances of very high concern (SVHC) published by the European Chemical Agency [ECHA] are present in some of our products above their respective thresholds.

All Weidmüller suppliers are informed about the REACH requirements and hence arising legal duties. If new SVHC are promulgated by the ECHA, or new materials or products are included in our portfolio declaration duties resulting from Article 33 can potentially apply. As soon as our suppliers report the presents of any SVHC in purchased goods and if the total amount of one SVHC exceeds the threshold of 0.1 % w/w in our products we will publishing these information in the online product catalogue at each product to enable our customers the fastest data exchange. If the REACH field is empty, no SVHC from the supply chain has been reported to us.

SCIP database

SCIP is the database for information on **S**ubstances of **C**oncern **I**n articles as such or in complex objects (**P**roducts) established under the Waste Framework Directive (WFD). Companies supplying articles containing substances of very high concern (SVHCs) on the Candidate List in a concentration above 0.1% weight by weight (w/w) on the EU market have to submit information on these articles to ECHA.

Weidmüller also fully complies with this obligation. There is no obligation to disclose the SCIP notification number corresponding to the product to third parties in this framework. However, in order to simplify further processes for our customers, we also provide the SCIP notification number in the online catalogue, directly below the REACH Article 33 information.
