

According to Article 33 (1) in the REACH regulation the manufacturer must provide customers with sufficient information on Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) contained in products in a concentration above 0.1% weight by weight (w/w) to allow safe use of the product.

With basis in above declaration BROEN has reported the listed products into the SCIP database.


To our best knowledge, any other products and packaging we deliver to you do not contain substances mentioned on the candidate list (SVHC) in quantities above 0.1 % w/w.

We have a continuous dialogue with our suppliers about the candidate list and the compliance, and we are going to inform you, if any changes will influence the products and/or packaging we deliver to you.
